### LIFE WITH THE MESSIAH

'...let us lay aside every weight and the sin that clings so closely and let us run with perseverance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus... who for the sake of the joy that was set before him endured the cross...' <a href="Hebrews">Hebrews</a> 12:1-2 (NRSV)

It is only in the fellowship of the Father, Son, and the Holy Spirit that we can become conformed to the image of Jesus. The mind of Christ is with us in the power of the Holy Spirit. As we move on through the weeks here at Derry First United Methodist Church, let us remember that we are in fellowship with the Messiah and we are being guided by God to spread the good news of God in Jesus Christ.
